Sharrows



What are sharrows?

Sharrows are pavement markings that are installed within shared travel lanes (lanes shared by cars and bicycles).

Why are they used?

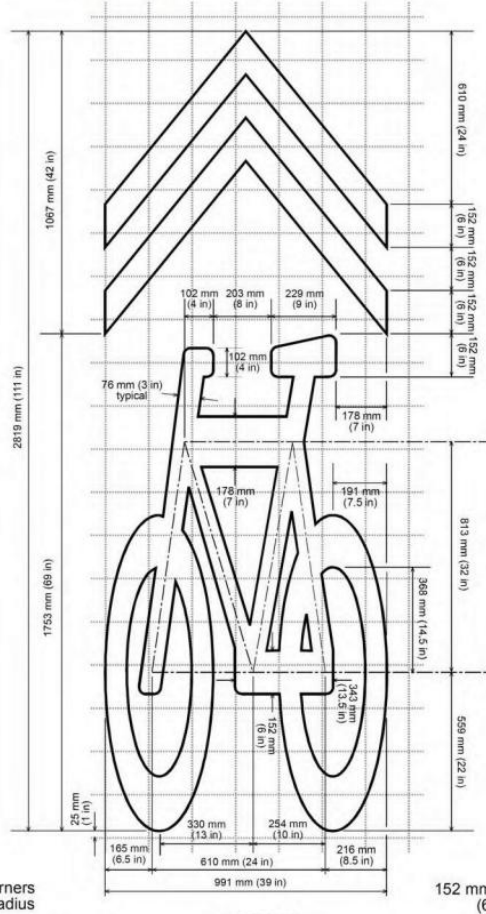
Sharrows can be helpful on streets where there is insufficient space to add bicycle lanes. Sharrows help cyclists position themselves within the lane safely to avoid being squeezed off the road or hit by suddenly opened car doors.

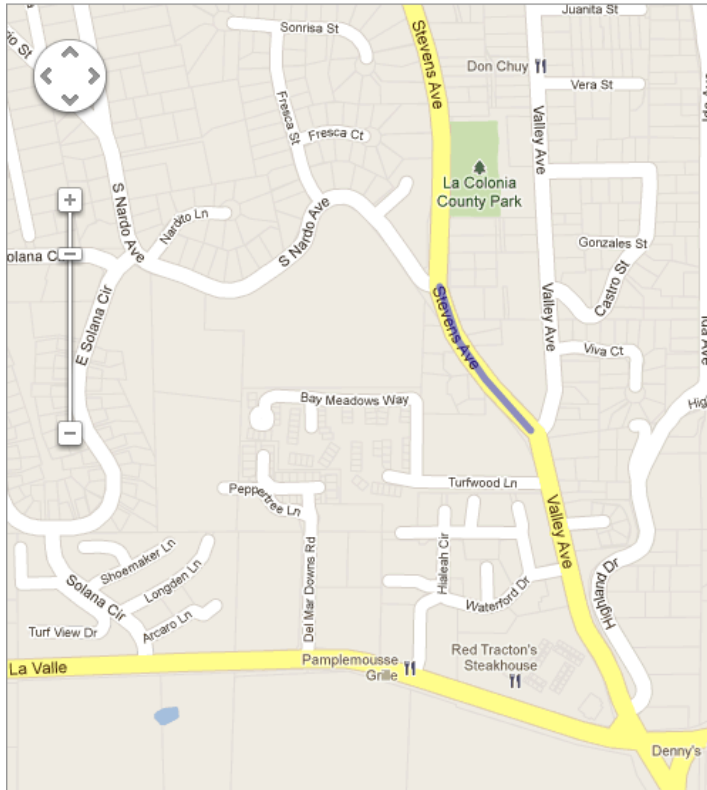

Figure 9C-104 (CA). Shared Roadway Bicycle Marking



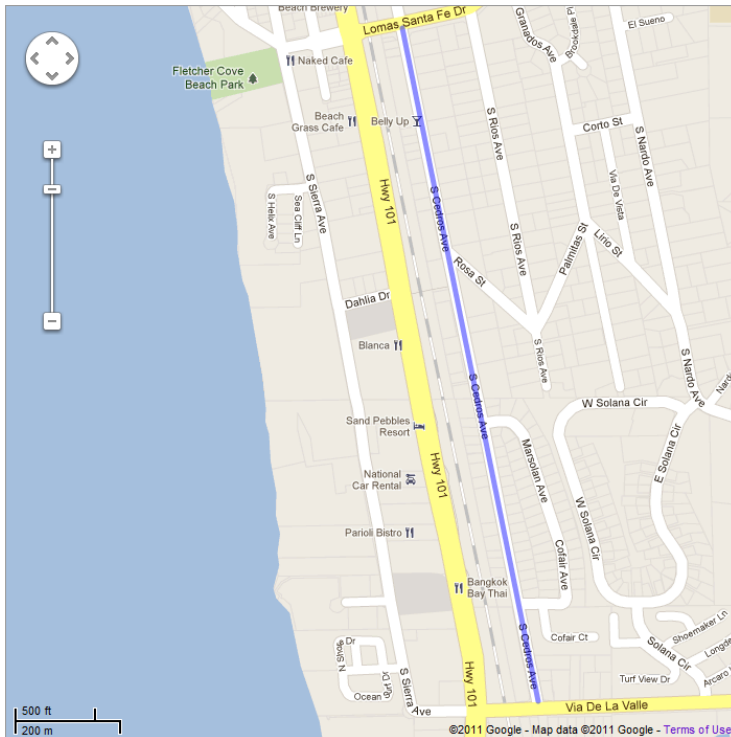
Stevens Avenue

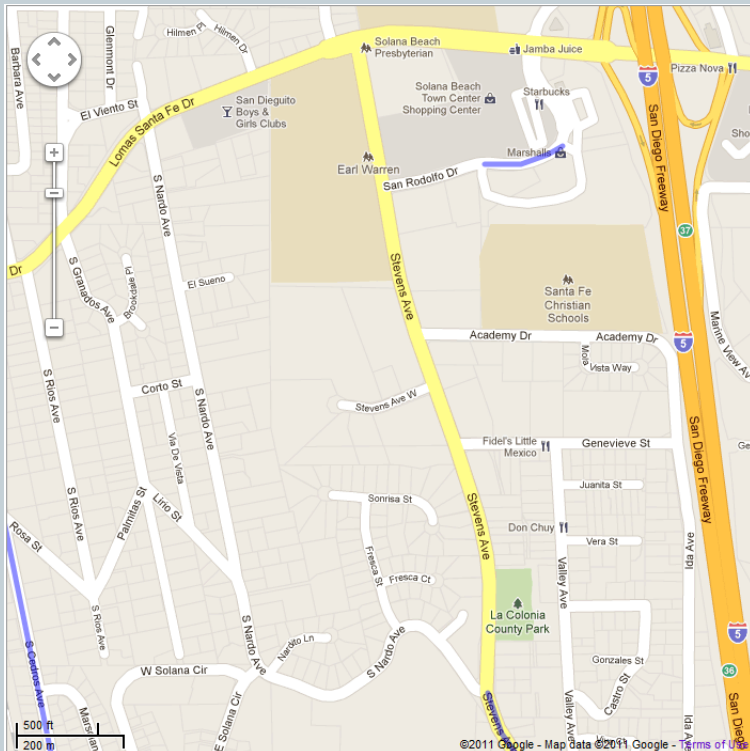

- Proposed by a member of the community to improve safety and encourage walking and biking.



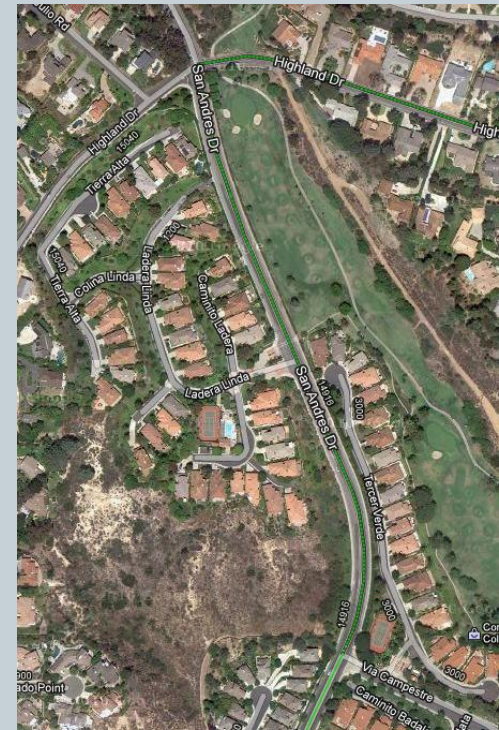
- Reduce to single lane

San Andreas Drive



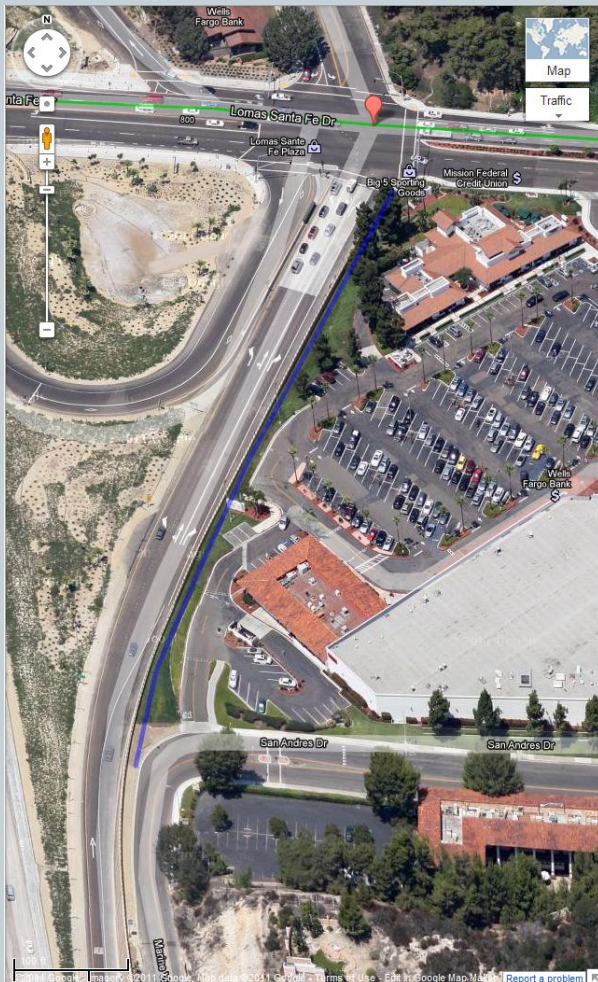

Pedestrian Path at Lomas Santa Fe Plaza



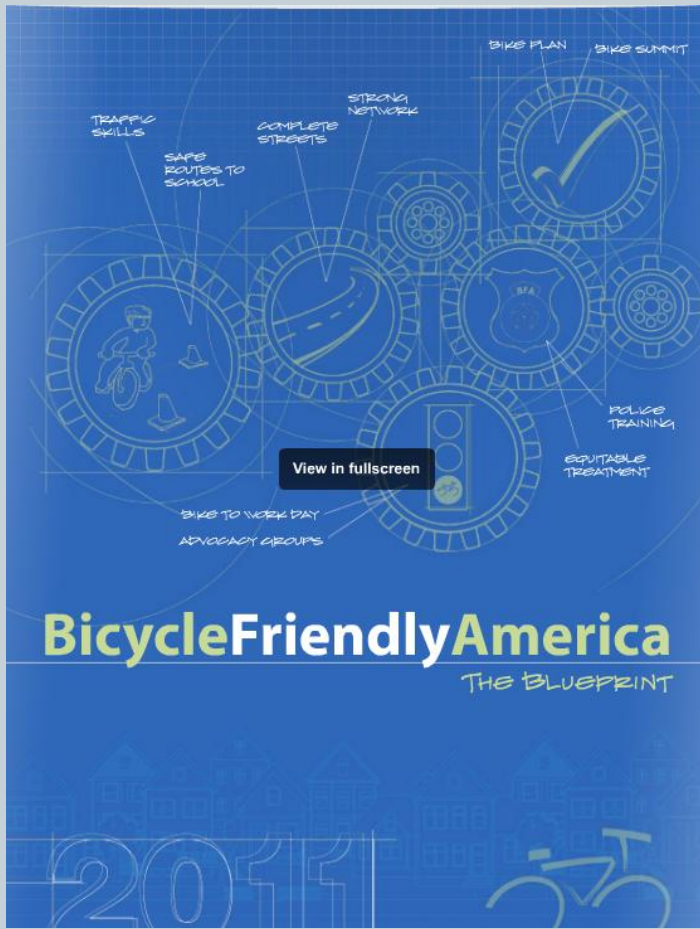
- Sidewalk was demolished when Marine View was closed to make way for off-ramp
