PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The City of Solana Beach was recently awarded a SANDAG grant to prepare its first Comprehensive Active Transportation Strategy (CATS). Active transportation is any self-propelled mode of travel, such as walking or cycling. The CATS will identify opportunities to improve both bicycle and pedestrian networks by increasing connectivity and enhancing safety for all users.
